LEED for HOMES Program Review: May 14, 2008

The New Mexico Chapter of the U.S. Green Building Council is sponsoring a LEED for Homes Program Review during *Sustainability Week*

LEED for Homes is a national, voluntary green building rating system that promotes the design and construction of high performance “green” homes. LEED for Homes is working collaboratively with local and regional rating systems already in place, as well as complimentary national programs. Here in New Mexico, a unique partnership has been developed between the USGBC-NM Chapter and Build Green New Mexico. Foundation for Building, a 501(c) (3) non-profit corporation, will be certifying homes under the LEED for Homes and Build Green NM programs.

Certified green homes can qualify for the State of New Mexico’s Sustainable Building Tax Credit for Residential Buildings. Tax Credits are available for both LEED for Homes and Build Green NM rating systems. Depending on the level of certification obtained, awards can be as high as \$11,000 (Build Green NM ‘Gold’ level) or \$22,450 (LEED for Homes ‘Platinum’ level). Come to this workshop and learn how to get your home certified under the LEED for Homes program.
